Child Care Healthy Initiatives Compliance

EFFECTIVE DATES

- ◆ Upon application, meet Boise City Code requirements.
- ◆ Upon application, all child care workers must have CPR and first aid certification from ASHI, AHA, or Red Cross.
- ◆ Within one year of licensing, workers must have complied with designated “level” training requirements.
- ◆ By March 1, 2015, all child care workers must have CPR and first aid certification from ASHI, AHA, or Red Cross.
- ◆ By July 1, 2015, all facility directors must be in compliance with the new ordinance.
- ◆ By October 1, 2015, all workers must be in compliance with the new ordinance.
- ◆ By October 1, 2015, new facilities must meet all requirements of the current Boise City Code.
- ◆ By October 1, 2015, each facility’s compliance evaluation rating will be reported at boisearchildcare.com. Compliance is not a requirement of licensing.
